

Rock Painting Rules



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Reservations must be made personally to paint the rock and are on a first come, first served basis.

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One family, group, or organization per day may paint the rock, unless you have paid for several days in succession.

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Reservations must be made by filling out the "Spirit Rock Reservation Request" form.

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You must confirm your reservation has been updated on the calendar prior to painting the rock. This calendar is normally updated within 24 hours of your reservation and payment received.

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The fee for 2026-2027 to reserve the rock is \$20 per day. Multiple days can be reserved based on availability.

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Once reserved, you have the rock for 24 hours, beginning at 4:00pm on the afternoon you reserved until 4:00pm of next day. The person who reserves the rock is responsible for providing the base coat. The rock must be painted by 8pm.

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The family or organization must supply paint, rollers, brushes, and appropriate clothing for painting the rock. All supplies and the area around the rock must be left as you found it. Please clean up after yourself and do not leave any paint or materials on or around the rock or on school property. Any damage to the school property as a result of painting the rock will be taken care of by the family or group that reserved the rock for that day.

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Krylon spray paint and acrylic paint is to be used to paint the rock and the painting may **ONLY** be done on the FRONT FLAT SIDE of the rock (the entire rock may NOT be painted).

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In the event of inclement weather, please email the Spirit Rock Coordinator (ptobeautification@rarhinosk12.com) to find the next open date for a substitution. This may or may not be the next school day as that day may already be reserved. No refunds.
